Before joining the IB’s academic staff, Robert worked with highly-diverse, economically-challenged schools implementing IB programmes of international education. A licensed secondary social studies and special education teacher, Robert has developed curriculum, led professional development, and consulted with schools in Africa, Europe, Asia and throughout the United States and Canada. He teaches in the IB Teacher Award Program as Adjunct Faculty with George Mason University’s Center for International Education. He holds a Ph.D. in Religion and Sociology (Ancient Near Eastern Studies) from Duke University, Durham, North Carolina.
